FOOTBALL

1st4sport Level 1 Certificate in Coaching Football (formerly FA Junior Team Managers Award)

The Level 1 Certificate in Football Coaching has been developed by the Football Association (FA) and is now awarded by 1st4sport Qualifications in partnership with the FA.

The content will include many popular and important elements of the Junior Team Managers Award, including the FA Emergency Aid and FA Child Protection workshop. This is the first accredited football coaching course qualification to incorporate interactive e-learning modules: Football Administration, Player and Coach Development, Laws of the Game, and Soccer Parent.

Along with support from on-line resources the FA will support the candidates by providing them with an FA Club Coach video.

The award has a working title of 'FA Club Coach Award' and will include an assessment. If candidates do not achieve or complete the Level 1 assessment then they will receive the 'FA Assistant Club Coach Award' enabling them to assist an appropriately qualified coach.

From the Level 1 there is progression into other areas of football including: Officiating, Administration and Sports Therapy.
